What is Burning Man?

Once a year tens of thousands of participants gather in Nevada's Black Rock Desert to create a community dedicated to art, self-expression and self-reliance. The participants ("Burners") visit from all over the world to participate in the days just before Labor Day. The cities of Reno and Sparks are the gateway to Burning Man (aka The Playa, Black Rock City). Grand Sierra Resort has been a welcome oasis for the Burners, and we make every effort to ensure the quality of each individual Guest experience.

Where Do I Unload My Vehicle

We know you are delightfully exhausted from your playa experiences so for your convenience we invite you to unload your belongings and luggage from your automobile or truck at the Valet Porte Cochere and a bell person will be happy to help you to your room. Do not unload trash at the main entrance. Do not use the main entrance Porte Cochere to load or unload your RV, trailer or oversized vehicle. Love the memories, leave the dust. We will have free compressed air dust-off stations available at the main entrances to ensure the playa stays in the great outdoors.

I Want to Leave No Trace

For the convenience of Hotel Guests trash dumpsters are provided on the East side of the property. Please keep the spirit of "Leave No Trace," and use them to not leave an unwelcome mess. \$50 per vehicle to utilize dumpsters. Access to dumpsters, Saturday, September 5 evening until Wednesday, September 9 morning.

Where Can I Park My RV?

RV, trailer and oversized vehicle parking is for registered hotel Guests only—be prepared to present your hotel reservation confirmation. Parking passes are available for purchase at the entrance to the RV Parking area in the East parking lot off Greg St. near the Truckee River (refer to map on reverse), for \$250 per vehicle. Display your parking pass prominently on the dashboard of your vehicle. Dry camping (sleeping/staying in vehicle), loitering and gathering is not allowed in parking areas. No semi-trucks.

We expect you will still be in playa mode but please be aware not everyone shares your boundless energy, enthusiasm and love of alkali dust. Be respectful of all Hotel Guests and enjoy a hot shower, however refrain from partying in your room or making excessive noise.
